
Going to DUBLIN Z00

TICKETS BOOKED!

Book your tickets online at www.dublinzoo.ie or purchase them at the entrance when you arrive. Additional needs and carer tickets can only be purchased at the entrance on the day of your visit, don't forget to bring your carer ID.

PACK YOUR BAG




WRISTBANDS
