ABOUT SANTA'S GROTTO



Santa's Grotto is located in the Farmhouse at Dublin Zoo, close to Family Farm. When visiting Santa's Grotto, visitors will have the exciting opportunity to meet Santa and his friendly elves.

Tickets to Santa's Grotto must be <u>pre-booked online at</u> <u>dublinzoo.ie</u>, either as part of a Zoo Day Entry Bundle or Wild Lights Bundle.

GETTING TO THE ZOO







If arriving by car, you will park in the Lord's Walk car park or in another area of the Phoenix Park.

Dublin Zoo has no car park of it's own but there are plenty of areas to park inside the Phoenix Park.



ARRIVING AT DUBLIN ZOO



This is what the entrance to Dublin Zoo looks like.

There may be a queue to get in and you may need to wait.

It's important that you arrive with enough time to get to Santa's Grotto for your pre-booked time slot. If you have booked a later time slot then you can enter Dublin Zoo earlier to explore the Zoo or Wild Lights.

You can bring some of your favourite items to help pass the time but please note, balloons, sparklers and scooters are not allowed at Dublin Zoo.



ARRIVING AT DUBLIN ZOO



This is where you will enter the Zoo for Santa Grotto's experiences that are part of a Day Entry OR Wild Lights Bundle.

A member of staff will need to scan your tickets in order for you to gain entry into the Zoo.

If you have a carer with you, they may be asked to show their carer ID before entering.


The map below shows where Santa's Grotto is located if you're visiting as part of a Day Entry Bundle.

ARRIVING AT SANTA'S GROTTO



When you arrive at Santa's Grotto, you will be greeted by Santa's friendly Elves.

The Elves will take your booking details and lead you to Santa's waiting room. While you're waiting to see Santa, the Elves may talk to you and play games. They may also ask to colour with you. If you would rather a quiet moment to yourself, there are books available for you to read.



YOUR SANTA VISIT



Santa's Grotto is lit with bright lighting.
There will also be gentle, festive music playing throughout the Grotto, at a low volume.

If the lights or noise bother you, please let one of Santa's Elves know and they will help.



YOUR SANTA VISIT



When it is your time to see Santa, the Elves will lead you into meet him. He is very excited to meet you!

While here, Santa might talk to you and he will give you a gift.

After you receive your gift, Santa's photographers can take some photos of you with Santa!

These photos can be collected when you exit Dublin Zoo.



LEAVING SANTA'S GROTTO



When it is time to leave Santa's Grotto, the Elves will lead you to the exit. Once you exit the Grotto, you may choose to leave Dublin Zoo or if there's still time, explore the Zoo or Wild Lights, whatever bundle was booked as part of your Santa's Grotto experience.

Please make sure you're aware of the Zoo and Wild Lights closing times on the day of your visit.

This year's theme is 'The Wild Kaleidoscope' and visitors in the evening will have the opportunity to experience the animal kingdom's most magical colours!





Throughout Wild Lights, will you see maps and signs like this, which will help you plan your route around.





During Wild Lights, nearly all of the animals at Dublin Zoo will be in bed with the curtains over their windows, so it is very unlikely you will see any animals.

But, if you're lucky, you might hear some noises like the lions roaring or the sea lions barking as you walk past their habitats.











Throughout Wild Lights, there are signs like this highlighting areas with strong smells, loud noises, big crowds, and steep surfaces.

There are also maps highlighting these areas too.
