Animal Bricktacular is a limited-time summer exhibition at Dublin Zoo featuring more than 40 life-sized animal sculptures made from 3.5 million bricks.

The exhibition runs from June 13th until the end of August and is included with standard Zoo admission.

-  enjoy interactive photo opportunities
-  follow the brick-built animal trail

-  and attend special bonus brick workshops on selected weekends



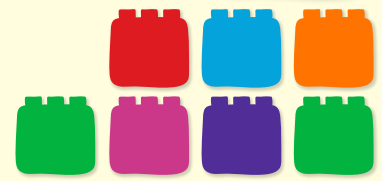
